COMMUNITY AWARD NOMINATION CATEGORIES

All awards recognize excellence in the category within the North Kitsap/Greater Poulsbo community. This award is given to the individual or business that has given back to the community

Person of the Year

Recognizes an individual's outstanding contribution to promoting a healthy community.

Volunteer of the Year (Pearce Dressel Award)

Recognizes an individual who has devoted an exceptional amount of unpaid time and effort for the benefit of the community, a non-profit organization, and/or for the individuals they serve.

Young Leader of the Year

Awarded to any individual, age 18-39, who exemplifies a commitment to the health and future of our community in his or her efforts in business and/or volunteer work.

Organization of the Year

Recognizes the non-profit or charitable organization that has made a significant, positive impact on our community.

Business of the Year

Awarded to the business that has shown excellence in growth, as an employer, and as a corporate citizen.

Emerging Business of the Year

Awarded to a business that is no more than five years old—or has been reinvented within that same time—that has quickly proven itself to be an asset to our community.
